# **BRIEF DESCRIPTION FIELDWORK 1 AND FIELDWORK 2**

**UNIVERSITAS PENDIDIKAN GANESHA**

## **Brief Description**

### **Fieldwork 1 and Fieldwork 2**

Fieldwork 1 and 2 are offered in both educational and non-educational study programs in Universitas Pendidikan Ganesha. Each has a study load of 21 ECTS (14 SKS). In educational study programs, Fieldwork 1 consists of three courses namely Teaching Practice 1 (3 ECTS), Teaching Practice 2 (12 ECTS), and Community Engagement (6 ECTS). The description is as follows:

- Teaching Practice 1 or Pengenalan Lapangan Persekolahan (PLP 1)  
Teaching Practice 1 is a precursor to student teaching. Students are asked to observe the teacher and take notes, noticing teaching style, management, and other focus areas their lecturers have asked them to observe.
- Teaching Practice 2 or Pengenalan Lapangan Persekolahan (PLP 2)  
Teaching Practice 2 is aimed at providing students an opportunity to practice and perform their ability to demonstrate their teaching skills in real situations and other school-related duties. This course includes 4 main activities, namely observation-orientation, guided training, independent training, and examination.
- Community Engagement or Kuliah Kerja Nyata (KKN)  
Community Engagement has a study load of 3 SKS (equivalent to 2 ECTS). The duration of the community engagement in the is 42 days in rural area. The objective of this course is to give an experience to the students through direct engagement in the community by identifying, analysing, as well as proposing solutions to social phenomenon. Students will learn to apply their knowledge and skills they have obtained at the university in order to create programs suitable to the need of the community where it takes place. This course does not only benefit students but also government and community in general. This is thematic in nature, meaning that the themes used for the programs are predetermined by the institution, but the detailed programs are adjusted to the characteristics of the area where community engagement is located.

In Fieldwork 2 students are able to choose one among eight activity schemes offered according to *Merdeka Belajar Kampus Merdeka* (Freedom to Learn – Independent Campus) framework by The Ministry of Education, Culture, Research, and Technology. Each of the scheme is explained as follows:

- Student Exchange

- Internship
- Teaching Assistantship
- Research
- Humanitarian Project
- Entrepreneurship
- Independent fieldwork
- Community Engagement

Meanwhile, in non-educational study programs, students may choose either different or similar activity among activity schemes at *Merdeka Belajar Kampus Merdeka* framework in Fieldwork 1 and 2.
